Happy May Day to you!



COUNCIL MINUTES SUMMARY April 8, 2024

Acceptance of Agenda: Motion to accept agenda: Bill Huelle; 2ndPastor Kathy, agenda accepted. Acceptance of March 11, 2024 minutes: Motion to accept: Grant Hinze; 2ndBill Huelle, minutes accepted

Board/Committee Reports:

Worship and Music: There will be an informational meeting for ushers and acolytes Sunday, April 14 following worship. Bill will meet with the ushers and Pastor Kathy with acolytes. Bill handed out and Ushers Duties sheet and it was reviewed, and corrections made. There was no Saturday night worship 3/30 and Holy Humor Sunday was to be 4/7. There will be no communion on the 20^{th} and 21^{st} as Pastor will be on vacation. A proposal was made to have no Saturday night services in June, July, or August. After discussion, there was a motion by the board of music and worship to accept this proposal and a 2^{nd} by Lynn Margheim. Motion accepted. Those services will resume in September pending the determination of the board of music and worship and council.

Stewards: They will not be hosting a BBQ this year. There will be a stewardship drive "kick off" meal on 9/22 immediately following worship. Envelopes for pledges will be sent in the September Tidings as well as a Time and Talents Sheet to be handed in that Sunday as well. Also, the time and talents sheet will be sent out electronically for those that would rather respond in that manner. Then on 9/29, before church services, Biblical Stewardship, and adult study, will be led by Pastor Kathy. Next meeting will be 4/22 at 6 PM.

Parish Education: They held and Easter breakfast and took in about \$500 for the kids going to New Orleans, Owls will be 4/10 with a program on Tanzania given by Pastor Kathy and the Huelle's, the middle school gathering has been cancelled, EPIC will be painting Pastor Kathy's fence 4/27 to gain funds for their New Orleans trip, JAM will host the Grab and Go lunches for April, Young at Heart will be 4/21, after coffee fellowship and they will have an Earth Day theme, Vacation Bible School will be on a Sunday, Monday and Tuesday evening this year June 23,24,25.

Outreach: More volunteers are needed for the Grab and Go lunches. JAM is hosting on 4/25, Shari Copsey and her crew are hosting 5/23 and Council will host on 6/27.

Financial Report: March: Beginning Balance \$30,937.46 Ending Balance: \$18,033.63

Pastor/Staff reports: Pastor reiterated that the Jr. High Youth Gathering that was to be held in Sidney has been cancelled and that the EPIC youth going to New Orleans will be painting her fence 4/27. President Shari then read a letter of resignation submitted by Youth and Family Director Angie Hinze effective June 30, 2024. She moved that with regret, to accept her resignation as of 6/30. Pastor Kathy 2nd, resignation accepted.

Old Business: Our current computer coverage via Bytes is for back-up and viruses. If we want more it would be and additional charge. Consensus was to just keep what we have now. The council retreat agenda was reviewed with additions and corrections made. Shari also reminded those that haven't completed their surveys to do so and get them turned in. They will be resent to those people.

<u>New Business</u>: With the latest blizzard and city-wide power outages in the area we discussed a process for church cancellation. That will be finalized at our retreat and then put in the Tidings now and again in the fall.

We will be enjoying a pasta bar, along with bread, salad, and dessert. Our program will be Scottsbluff High School's Italian exchange student Benedeta Rossini.


CLCW MAY MISSION PROJECT: Sullivan Hills Camp


