Dear Calvary,

We know this is not the news you wanted to see or hear, but the Church Council, after meeting online on March 25th, is in consensus that the suspension of in-person worship and events over 10 people should continue until at least the first of May. Determination about services beyond that will be decided at a later date. Yes, this means that our Holy Week and Easter services will be online via Facebook Live as we have done the last few weeks. (Please look for the article elsewhere in this newsletter, if you need information on how to worship with us online.) This also means that Confirmation Sunday, originally scheduled for April 26th, has been postponed until a later, yet to be determined, date.



We are still in the process of trying to figure out what our Holy Week and Easter services will look like, but we are looking to find ways to make our worship more interactive. For example, towards the back of this newsletter you will find a couple of printable palm branch sheets. We encourage you to print off a copy for each person in your family so that when we do the Procession of Palms litany, you will have a palm branch to raise and wave. Also, because we were unable to cancel our Palm order as it was already in transit, we will have live palm branches available outside the office, if you would want to stop by a few days before Palm Sunday (April 5) to pick up palm branches for you and your family. And don't forget to check out our Website, Facebook page and your email as Holy Week gets closer for other possible ideas to help make our worship together, even though we are scattered, meaningful and special.

In the letter we initially sent out informing the congregation that we would not be able to gather for in-person worship, we asked you to remember that the expenses of the church continue even though we are not able to gather together for a time, and so many of you have responded by sending in and dropping off your offerings or signing up for electronic giving on our website. Pastor Chris and I are truly humbled by your generosity and support of the church and its ongoing ministries. We feel blessed to be a part of such a gracious and giving congregation.

As I think about celebrating Easter in these days of the Covid-19 pandemic, I am struck by the angel's' words to the women who came to Jesus' tomb in Mark 16, "you are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has been raised; he is not here. But go, tell his disciples and Peter that he is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see him." The truth is, we do not know what all the future holds, but we know who holds the future. The resurrected Christ goes before us and wherever we may go, whatever may happen, Jesus will meet us there; indeed Jesus walks with us and he will see us through.



Like you, we grieve the loss of being able to gather together in these days, especially for the holy days of Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter, but imagine what a celebration it will be when we can once again gather together as the family of God. Until then, please know that you are in our prayers but more importantly, know that the risen Christ goes before us!

Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!!! Pastor Sheryl

COUNCIL MINUTES SUMMARY

April 13, 2020

Board/Committee Reports:

Outreach – Mary Jo Huelle reporting. Next meeting after Easter; decals are ordered, invitations to Easter services are ready and available.

Elders – Dennis Gorr reporting for Neal Blomenkamp see Office Manager discussion below.

Social Ministries - Jack Martin reporting. Served a Wednesday night meal – approx. 75. Habitat for Humanity house was dedicated on Saturday.

Trustees - Jim Dorn reporting. Crew stripped the old wax off the stairs to the altar area. Resealed, polished; the baseboards were stained and installed around the Narthex area. Recycle boxes for bulletins are completed, thank you Bill Huelle. Roof people will look at the leak and give us a report. The insurance will not pay anything (hail damage) on the roofs.

Worship & Music - Dennis Gorr reporting Holy Week is all planned. There have been good attendance figures for both Wednesday night services. Trustees met for 2+ hours to work on tuning the projection screens for worship. A 70" TV will be mounted on the balcony so people in the front serving the congregation can see what is showing on the screen. The best purchase arrangements are being worked on. It is coming as soon as the TV is purchased.

Stewards – Pastor Chris reporting. The Generosity Project was a success. Looking at yearly plan for Stewardship and a theme.

Parish Education – still struggling to meet. Angie has Wednesday nights going strong with great support from Val Rahrs.

Financial Report: No report this month, will be given next month.

Pastor's /Staff Reports:

Lent moving along. Attendance is good.

Old Business:

40 people attended the Generosity Project from 4-5 different churches. Exercises were inclusive of all generations. Very helpful and gave good ideas.

Office Manager update – Christy Thompson is doing very well, started on Monday, March 2nd. Mary Jo worked with her for a week. Christy is very excited about the job. On Wednesdays she will need to leave around 2, during tennis season to take her daughter to practice. She'll flex time to make up the difference.

New Business:

Covid-19 discussion - CDC is recommending those over 60 not attend large group functions. Executive Committee addressed the issue; added wipes, spray bottles with bleach, disinfectant bottles. Other churches are moving to recommending NOT shaking hands during Passing the Peace. Water will not be in baptismal font; suggested offering plates are not passed but a receptacle at the rear of the church; hymnals should be cleaned; communion servers should wash hands well. Could set up a Facebook live for worship if needed; sermons are already on line. Tables used should be washed with soap, then rinsed off, then sanitizer sprayed and wiped down.

Discussion about whether or not we should re-evaluate our insurance, since claims have been difficult to get settled. Will put decision on next month's agenda.

The criteria for receiving a scholarship is as follows:

- 1. Attends Calvary Lutheran Church regularly and has had past record of two years attendance in Sunday School and/or worship.
- 2. Is a voting member as defined in the Calvary Lutheran Church Constitution Chapter 8 Part C8.02C.
- 3. Will be full time student as defined by the college attending.
- 4. Has not received scholarships from Calvary for more than eight college semesters (limit 3). Requests for scholarships exceeding the eight college semesters, will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee.



Worship With Us Live and Online

To worship with us live and online, simply log on to Facebook and go to our Facebook page: Calvary Lutheran Scottsbluff, a few minutes before the worship start time. If you are watching on a phone or tablet, you should see a banner across your screen that says 'Calvary Lutheran is Live', click on the banner to go to the live video. If you are on a computer, you will need to scroll down our Facebook page until you see a video with a red button



that says live, click on the 'play' arrow to activate the live video. We will also save the video to our Facebook page for viewing at a later time and will place the link on our website: calvarylutheranscottsbluff.org. If you use the link on our webpage, you do not even need to be a Facebook user to access the video. Bulletins with congregational responses and hymns for the worship services will be placed on our website and also emailed to everyone who is on our Calvary Lutheran email list, so you may download or print off the bulletin ahead of time to more fully participate in the worship service wherever you may be. The bulletin will also include weekly announcements and prayer lists. Not on our Calvary email list? Contact the church office, and give us your email address and we will be happy to add you to our list.


April Mission Project



Fold a piece of green construction paper in half and paper clip the template so the dotted line is along the fold.


Cut through the template and both layers of construction paper along the black lines.


Discard the template (unless you want to make more leaves).


Unfold the construction paper to see your finished palm leaf.


Optional: Tape a green pipe cleaner or thin rolled tube of construction paper to the center as a stem.
