COUNCIL MINUTES SUMMARY

March 13, 2023

Acceptance of Agenda – Bill Huelle moved to accept; Lynn Margheim 2nd – accepted. Acceptance of minutes from February 13, 2023: Becky Martin moved to accept; Shari Copsey 2nd – accepted.

We did a short feedback exercise where we were invited to speak freely about Pastor Brett's time here at Calvary Lutheran Church. Good feedback from us to him, and from him to us.

Board/Committee Reports:

Outreach: They are working on getting some Easter postcards ready to bring awareness to our Easter service. Waiting for details from the Worship and Music committee. Discussed possibly doing a BBQ as a fundraiser. Not much interest. Discussed Saturday night service in the future.

Elders: Vicki Schmidt will serve as the Substitute Chair until Neal is able to return. We discussed pulpit supply and what that might look like in the coming months. We discussed flexible worship times to accommodate Bill Huelle doing services in Kimball and also here at Calvary Lutheran Church.

Social Ministries: They had a home dedication with Habitat for Humanity on 3/12/23.

Worship & Music: They worked on and discussed Easter services at their meeting.

Endowment committee: Bill shared the requests and passed out the final decision of money allocated. Approval was needed. Jim Dorn moved to accept; Deb Brown 2nd-accepted.

Pastor's /Staff Reports: Pastor Brett met with the elders and shared the upcoming activity. Pastor Brett emailed the Synod office and shared his thoughts and perspective about his time at Calvary Lutheran Church. Angie reported that JAM hasn't been meeting because of Lenten services. Pastor Brett reported that there is an April funeral scheduled and a wedding scheduled, and the Synod office did say they will take care of getting a Pastor here to perform these.

<u>Old Business</u>: We are looking to do an outreach event. Maybe doing a BBQ after church for church goers after our Sunday service. Endowment committee report-the funds were approved. Lenten Meal-March 22nd- the kids will serve this.

New Business: Lynn Margheim updated us on the status of the call committee. Discussed service times for Holy Week. There will be no Easter Breakfast.




CLCW MAY MISSION PROJECT: CALVARY KITCHEN SHOWER
