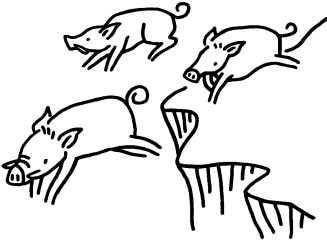

Daily Bible Readings @ Home

Sunday – Read Mark 5:14-20 The demoniac is healed and shares the good news. How have you experienced God's healing in your life? Share that good news with those you know.

Monday – Read Psalm 103:1-5 Bless the Lord, o my soul! Pray today's reading as a prayer.

Tuesday – Read Psalm 103:6-14 The Lord's steadfast love endures forever. Tell a family member or friend that you love them!

Wednesday – Read Psalm 103:15-22 God's love is from everlasting to everlasting. Write your own psalm of praise. Choose a characteristic of God, like God's love, healing, or presence in your life, and write a few sentences describing what it means to you!

Thursday – Read Psalm 23 The Lord is our shepherd. Write this psalm in a card and send it to a friend going through a tough time.

Friday – Read Psalm 1 Happy are those who love the Lord. What might it look like to plant your roots deep into the streams of God's living water? What do you need to do to make that happen?

Saturday – Read Mark 5:21-34 Jesus heals a woman in need. Pray for someone you know who is in need of healing. Is there something you can do physically to support that person like provide a meal, help with a chore around the house, drive them to appointments, etc? Reach out and offer to help.
