December 11, 2023

Acceptance of Agenda – Neal Blomenkamp moved to accept; Bill Huelle 2nd - accepted. Acceptance of minutes from November 13, 2023: Neal Blomenkamp moved to accept; Shari Copsey 2nd – accepted.

Board/Committee Reports:

Elders: Neal did have a question about doing a background check on incoming church staff as we have done in the past. He will check on that.

Trustees: They put up the nativity scene.

Parish Education: December 17th is the caroling party. They are still working on forming a "young adult group" here at the church.

Call Committee: All of the paperwork has been turned in. The Installation of Pastor Kathy will be on 1/21/2024 at 2 p.m.

Worship and Music: They set the December worship schedule. There will be no worship services on Saturday 12/23/23 or Saturday 12/30/23.

Endowment: All applications are due at the end of January 2024.

Social Ministry: The Angel tree has been taken care of. The Habitat house is progressing. Laundry Love is coming up in January 2024. The Salvation Army Bell ringing went well.

Nominating Committee: We went over the list, and she shared an update on several people volunteering for different committees. Still a few left to fill.

Financial Report: Beginning Balance for October: \$37,158 - Ending Balance: \$35,608 *** The church was given a \$20,000. Anonymous gift that was to be added to the building fund.***
