

COUNCIL MINUTES SUMMARY

May 8, 2023

Acceptance of Agenda – Neal Blomenkamp moved to accept; Bill Huelle 2nd – accepted. Acceptance of minutes from April 10, 2023: Bill Huelle moved to accept; Jim Dorn 2nd – accepted.

Board/Committee Reports:

Outreach: Becca made postcard type announcements to hand out at services and possibly at Laundry Love and to the public, informing them of our worship services and times. We discussed various ideas for fundraising, however we are concerned if we will have enough volunteers to make it happen. We decided on a BBQ-less BBQ for fundraising and to have a picnic in the park following a Sunday service for church fellowship.

Elders: They updated Neal on what's been going on in his absence. Bill is helping to get pulpit supply taken care of on the dates that he won't be here. Jim Dorn will be available to help others in Bill's absence by unlocking the doors and helping them get set up, or things they may have questions about.

Trustees: They got the trailer unloaded, turned off the heat and are getting ready to start mowing and sprucing up the outside.

Worship & Music: Sunday online services are running smooth now. Needed some tweaking with some internet wires. He stated that we will need to be flexible with some changes to the contemporary and traditional services schedule as people will be gone and such.

Parish Education: The final OWLS meeting this year was on May 3rd. The last JAM meeting will be on May 10th. They plan to have a pizza party and fun games. They celebrated the graduates at the service on May 7th. VBS is on the calendar for July 20-22. The theme will be "Pets Unleashed". All programming will start back up in September.

Financial Report: Mary Jo Huelle reporting in Grant's absence. Beginning Balance for April: \$8,439 Ending Balance: \$24,064

Pastor's /Staff Reports: Angie Hinze reported all the information that is under the Parish Ed category. She was very pleased with the attendance at the end of the year. The programs finished strong. PMA Bill Huelle reported the various updates on pulpit supply and that he has messages out to have dates covered.

<u>Old Business:</u> Mary Jo Huelle reported that The Call committee have all their duties done and up to date. We have not been given any candidates yet, however, we are already to go and ready to interview. Deb Brown updated us that we are planning to have a picnic in the park after church service with church goers, sometime in August. We have a June wedding scheduled and Bill Huelle confirmed that we will have a Pastor from Sidney coming to do this.

<u>New Business:</u> There will be no Saturday evening services on June 3rd and Bill will be at Synod Assembly. We will let people know ahead of time. He will mention it at his Saturday night services and it will be in the bulletin. Mary Jo contacted Grant that they will need a check for Synod Assembly in June.
