

DEVOTIONS

Think about devotions as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

GATHERING

✠ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

✠ Prayer of the Week

Almighty God, you have gathered us into your mission of love all nations. Equip us to first support each other. As we learn and practice our faith, may we each then be sent out as your visible love in this world. Remind us that you have promised to be with us, even to the end of time. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- ❓ **Highs & Lows:** Name something good you heard today. Name something not so good you heard.
- ❓ **Thinking About This Week's Story:** The disciples were told to go out into the world and tell others about Jesus. There are many ways to share the love of Jesus with others. We can tell people with our words and with our actions through kindness and love. Who were you kind to today? Who was kind to you?
- ❓ **Getting Ready for Next Week's Story:** The disciple, Peter, learns in a dream that there are no food restrictions on what he can eat. Name one food that tasted good today. Name one food that didn't taste good.

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

✠ Dear God, Teach me to _____. Help me _____. Amen.

CLOSING

✠ If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.

✠ Rituals & Traditions: A Blessing to Share

With permission, mark one another with the sign of the cross on the forehead, and say: **Go in peace. God will be with you always. Amen.**
