Board/Committee Reports:

Outreach: Becca spoke about social media and the posting of information on the Church's FB page. People are interested in the amount of supplies needed; the following are some statistics:

3 sheets per quilt = 1,008 (one sheet for the middle and one for the back.) Cotton or cotton blend old sheets, pillowcases and fabric are best. They CANNOT use flannel, knit, or polyester fabric because they stretch. Sheets with stains can be used in the middle.

Fun Quilting Facts

- 48 blocks for each top = $16,128 \ 10$ " blocks equaling 2.55 miles end to end
- 300" of border = 8,400' or 1.6 miles. Blocks and border are the 3rd sheet per auilt.
- 108 yarn ties = 45' per quilt or 2.86 miles of yarn. They have been blessed with an oversupply of yarn and do NOT need more!
- 310 yards of thread per quilt or 59.2 miles of thread (only an estimate!) If you can use a sewing machine, iron, or tie a knot, they have something for you to do and would sure enjoy your company Tuesday afternoons from 1-3:00.

The Calvary Quilters make quilts each Tuesday to send to needy countries once a year, via the Lutheran World Relief organization. The CLCW provides the hardworking quilters with a luncheon once or twice a year and contributes to the shipping costs for more than 300 quilts made annually. Novem-
