

COUNCIL MINUTES SUMMARY

August 8, 2022

Acceptance of Agenda – Bill Huelle moved to accept; Shari Copsey 2^{nd} - accepted. Acceptance of minutes from July 10, 2023: Shari Copsey moved to accept; Deb Brown 2^{nd} – accepted.

Board/Committee Reports:

Social Ministries: They did not meet. He did mention that they have been doing a little work with the latest Habitat for Humanity Project.

Trustees: They did not meet. Still working on bids and decisions on the AC unit.

Worship & Music: They met and talked about our Church in the Park Sunday. He also reported that the new musician is doing great!!

Parish Education: They did not meet. All activities will start up after Labor Day.

Call Committee: They met with the contact person for rural ministry in the state.

Financial Report: Beginning Balance for July: \$23,644 Ending Balance: \$32,823 *noted that \$50,000 was transferred from the Common Account and placed in a CD at PVB.

Pastor's /**Staff Reports:** PMA Bill Huelle reported that he helped with VBS and that they did a pet Blessing on that Saturday. Overall things are going well in the church. Angie Hinze reported that they had a dozen kids for VBS and around 20-25 people overall with the helpers. It went well. She is gearing up for the fall programming.

Old Business: Mary Jo Huelle reported that the directory will be finished VERY soon! Reminder that the church service in the park will be on 8/20/23. We discussed the time/talent sheets. Grant will take this to the Stewardship committee and see what they think is best. Nominating Committee-Mary Jo Huelle reported that they are looking for another member and that they will be getting active in September.

<u>New Business</u>: Discussed the details of the retirement celebration for Rhonda. We discussed how we can monitor our online worshippers and ways they can reach out to the church if they might need support or help. We thought maybe the outreach committee could investigate this. We discussed what the church might like to do for honoring Pastor Larry Spomer for 60 years of service at a function in the state in October. Report back at September meeting. We were informed that we are meeting with Pastor Montira A2B on Friday 8/25 @ 5pm @ Calvary.

CLCW September Mission Project




Domestic violence is a constant concern in our local communities.
Scottsbluff/Gering provides access to a 24 hour crisis hotline and a shelter, where those trying to escape abuse may find refuge. The shelter is always grateful for cash donations to help people set up new households. Some needed supplies: Non-perishable foods, brooms, mops, buckets, paper tow-

els, and sponges. Other items needed: dishes, pots/pans, silverware, small knives, can openers, potato peelers, stirring spoons, etc., toys, books, puzzles for the kids, sanitary products, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, toothbrush, hair brush, combs, shaving cream, nail clippers, nail files, and bodywash. <u>No clothing, please.</u> Donations may be placed in the tan *"Designated Giving"* envelopes in the pews.
